

## JD-0001 Jodi "Smiles" Huisentruit

Updated: November 21, 2023

The following is a compilation of information through a decade of investigative interviews with Jodi's family, friends, coworkers, and communication with Jodi since June 11, 2013.

On April 4, 1995 Billy Pruin was shot with his own gun as he entered his residence. He tells us he had no warning, ambushed for something he wasn't supposed to know. His good friend Jodi would then start her own secret investigation into Billy's death that was "officially" ruled as suicide. Billy had been confiding in Jodi months prior to his assassination that he had stumbled on a drug ring in [REDACTED]. Around March of 1995 Jodi began taking self-defense classes sensing a potential threat with her surroundings. Jodi would investigate what Billy shared and acquired significant amount of information secretly. She planned on doing a big news story on it to help launch her career and vindicate Billy Pruin.

As fate would have it, [REDACTED] was a part of this drug ring and would discover that Jodi knew too much. Only days before her murder she would say she was changing her phone number because she was getting unwanted calls, potentially threats from those who knew she knew. Also, [REDACTED] would overhear Jodi at the country club and report back that Jodi knew everything about the drug ring in the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] would order her immediate killing.

A plan was thrown together and implemented on the morning of June 27, 1995. [REDACTED] would pre-dig multiple holes to be ready for Jodi's dismembered parts. He would injure his right shoulder doing this. [REDACTED] would wait in the parking lot in the early morning hours Tuesday June 27 in his white Ford work van for Jodi to go to her vehicle and abduct her in the dark. [REDACTED] walked up behind her with a towel wrapped around both hands and clothes lined her around the neck and dragged her to the van. Jodi would fight for her life and scream, so [REDACTED] had to strike her in the head on the left side and render her unconscious. He then drove her to the [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had the shed set up like a laboratory to dissect Jodi for disposal.

Upon arriving Jodi would fight so hard they had to handcuffed her hands together and used a hammer to shatter her right knee cap and [REDACTED]. Then [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and picked her up and placed her [REDACTED]. Jodi then describes how difficult it was to breathe with [REDACTED]. But she still fought to her last breath.

Bleeding significantly from [REDACTED], and in significant pain she was struggling for consciousness. [REDACTED] would take a bottle of chemicals, like bleach, [REDACTED], and be in even more pain. He then [REDACTED] and she describes looking down seeing [REDACTED]. She would then have [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then cut both of her hands off and handed them to [REDACTED] for disposal so the fingerprints would be separated from the body. Jodi describes the significant blood draining from her arms, and that this was what finally killed her, bleeding out.

Jodi would continue to watch after leaving her body as they [REDACTED] her dead body, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] and pull all of the teeth out of it so it couldn't be identified through dental records. The most brutal savage things you could ever expect to do to humans, they did them all to Jodi. She often repeats everyone will throw up when they hear it.

Meanwhile, while they [REDACTED] left with the hands and her personal belongings still in the van from the abduction. He would drive to a field at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] to a hole already dug for her. He tossed her hands, [REDACTED], into that hole. Partially buried the hands and then tossed in the rest of her personal belongings. [REDACTED] kept some of the evidence as a trophy (listed below). In a classic return to the scene of the crime [REDACTED] then made an appearance at Jodi's apartment still shellshocked from the horrific events he participated in. He would even momentarily forget his last name when officers asked who he was. Later in the evening [REDACTED] would return again to Jodi's apartment as told first hand to us by a woman who actually got in the van and rode home to [REDACTED] place. This woman said [REDACTED] kept repeating "Why did they do this to me." Very agitated, angry and shook up. This woman would eventually feel very uneasy around [REDACTED], and even use his phone to call her mom to say if anything happened to her [REDACTED] was the last person she was with. Adding to his odd behavior, at about 4:30 AM the next morning [REDACTED] agitatedly would make her get up to take her home stating he had to get to work. But when they went outside, she went to his work van, and he snapped at her to stay away from it, they weren't taking that van. She questioned why, because he said he had to go to work. He demanded she get in the other vehicle. [REDACTED] took the woman home, but eventually came home that evening and hid his trophies and then burned the van.

We have been told there was a man known to be associated with an Incinerator around [REDACTED] that would make evidence and anything "disappear". We believe [REDACTED] took some of Jodi's cut up parts to him. While other parts were buried further south of her hands.

But namely Jodi wants [REDACTED] for all the world to see what was going on and the reason for her disappearance and brutal murder.

**Status on the legal case:**

In 2017 John Vansice was brought in for questioning at which time a Grand Jury issued indictments that have been sealed until such time as they choose to act on them. Each year annually the indictments are unsealed and read before a judge and Grand Jury and a decision is made to either act on the indictments, seal them up for another year, or dismiss them.
